**ENTRY:** Thursday, August 20, 12 pm - 7 pm  
*Please remove all displays on either removal day.*

**REMOVAL:** Monday, August 31, 8 am - 4 pm  
 Tuesday, September 1. 2 pm - 6 pm

**LOCATION:** Entered and displayed inside and outside bottom floor of Agricultural Hall

*Adult and junior entries will be judged separately unless noted*

Check appropriate group on entry form.

**CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:**

1. All entries must be grown, selected and arranged by exhibitor except wild flowers in arrangements and unless otherwise noted.
2. Exhibitors are requested to restore and freshen exhibits.
3. **One entry per class per exhibitor.**

4. The committee reserves the right to reject any entry.
5. Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the judges.
6. **Do not use an expensive container.** The Fair is not responsible for loss of items. Containers will be provided for the Garden Flower category C 1 – C 24 only.
7. Potted plants must have been owned by the exhibitor for six weeks prior to the Fair.
8. Collect blooms in their prime. Do not include buds, seed pods, artificial material or any evidence of insects, disease or spray injury. Place plant material in a cool place, out of drafts in deep water for a few hours.
9. Conditioning plant material is recommended.
10. **Excellence in Horticulture Award and Popular Choice Awards Award**  
 A \$10 prize will go to 1 adult and 1 junior in each category. Winners will be announced on Sunday, 8/30.
